


I am going on a trip to the B&O Railroad Museum!




On this trip I will be Trick-or-Treating in the Roundhouse.



When I go to the museum I can wear a Halloween costume or I can wear my regular clothes. Whatever makes me comfortable!




When we arrive we will walk into the main entrance.



Then, we will check in at the front desk.



After check-in we will go to the Information Desk in the Roundhouse. We can get a map of the Trick-or-Treat activities, a "passport" to track how many stations we have visited, and borrow a sensory kit if I would like one.



All the candy stations and activities will be inside the Roundhouse. I will not be able to visit other parts of the museum. I can look at the map to see where things are.



The candy stations will in front of steam engines and railcars, there will be 10 stations.



Halloween themed activities will be on the turntable in the middle of the Roundhouse. Activities will include a craft, sensory table, and a game.



I can visit as many or as few candy stations as I want, I can also visit the same station more than once! When I visit a station I can get a stamp in my "passport". I do not have to do any activities I do not want to, its all up to me!
